**REGULATIONS OF TICKET SALES
AND
PARTICIPATION IN AN EDUCATIONAL EVENT ORGANIZED BY
THE POLISH ROYAL OPERA**

I. TICKET SALES

1. Tickets entitling to participate in an educational event organized by the Polish Royal Opera (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer") are bearer tickets.
2. Tickets are sold online via the sales platform <https://kicket.com/warszawa> under the terms and conditions set out in the regulations of the platform <https://kicket.com/s/regulamin> and on the day of the event and its location, provided tickets for the event are still available.

II. INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS OF AN EDUCATIONAL EVENT

1. The educational event organized by the Organizer takes place in the Royal Theater in the Old Orangery of the Royal Łazienki Museum in Warsaw and is intended for children of the age specified in the event description and their adult guardians who take full responsibility for their children during the event.
2. Participants of the educational event are asked to leave their outerwear in the cloakrooms available at the event location. The organizer is not responsible for personal items left at the event venue.
3. Participants who arrive late will be allowed into the auditorium only during the break.
4. Smoking is strictly prohibited at the venue of the educational event.
5. In the auditorium, stage and foyer of the Theater, consumption of drinks and food is strictly prohibited.
6. Audio recording, photography, or video recording of an artistic performance during the educational event is strictly prohibited.
7. The Organizer informs that the educational event may be audiovisually recorded, or photos from the event may be taken, which will be used to promote the Organizer's activities; therefore, by participating in the event, the participant gives consent to

possible registration (recording) free of charge, unlimited in terms of territory, time and quantity, and disseminating your image and the image of the minor in your care in connection with participation in an educational event.

8. The participant undertakes to sign an appropriate declaration at the location of the educational event before it starts.
9. Participants who do not comply with the instructions of the theatre staff in the event of violating these Regulations or posing a threat to the safety of other participants will be asked to leave the event venue without the possibility of obtaining a refund of the purchased tickets.
10. Participation in the educational event is tantamount to reading and accepting these Regulations.
11. These Regulations enter into force on the day of their publication on the Organizer's website. The Organizer reserves the right to introduce changes to these Regulations. Any changes to the Regulations made by the Organizer become effective after they are published on the Organizer's website.
12. In matters not regulated by these Regulations, the provisions of the Act of April 23, 1964, Civil Code and other provisions of generally applicable law shall apply.
