

**DECLARATION OF CONSENT FOR IMAGE PROCESSING AND USE
OF A PARTICIPANT IN THE EDUCATIONAL EVENT
ORGANIZED BY THE POLISH ROYAL OPERA**

I, the undersigned, _____,

hereby grant free, unlimited territorial, temporal, and quantitative consent for my image, as well as the image of my minor ward:

to be photographed during workshops organized by the Polish Royal Opera, headquartered at 00-695 Warsaw, Nowogrodzka 4.

I hereby authorize the Opera, as well as its sponsors and partners cooperating in the organization of educational events, to use and disseminate, free of charge and on multiple occasions, the image of myself and my minor ward. This authorization includes dissemination on websites, in publications, and through any other media or channels of information distribution, for informational, educational, and promotional purposes related to the activities of the Polish Royal Opera, its sponsors, and partners.

The Polish Royal Opera declares that the photos taken will not violate the personal rights of the aforementioned individuals.

This authorization includes the use of the image in the following fields of exploitation:

1. In the scope of photographing the image – producing any number of copies using any technique, including digital methods.
2. In the scope of distributing the original or copies containing the image.
3. In the scope of distributing the work in ways other than those mentioned in point 2 – public display, presentation, playback, as well as the right to modify, alter, and create derivative works, summaries, or adaptations of the work.

This authorization also includes the right to make modifications to all or parts of the image, add additional photos, graphic elements, text, captions, and any digital processing of the image.

I hereby agree not to raise any claims against the above-mentioned entities utilizing the image, including financial claims, for its recording or use.

I declare that I have been informed about the principles of the future processing of my image and the rights I have in this regard.

INFORMATION CLAUSE

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter "GDPR"), we inform you that:

1. The administrator of the personal data of participants in educational events (hereinafter: "Participants") is the Polish Royal Opera, headquartered at 00-695 Warsaw, Nowogrodzka 49 (hereinafter: the "Opera").
2. In accordance with applicable regulations, a Data Protection Officer has been appointed. For any questions or requests related to personal data protection, please contact the Officer in writing at the Opera's registered office address or by email at: iod@operakrolewska.pl.
3. Participants' personal data in the form of their image will be processed for the purpose of documenting events organized by the Opera and for promotional purposes, based on the consent granted (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR). Personal data provided for registration for events will be processed for the purpose of enabling participation in such events, i.e., for the conclusion and performance of a contract (Article 6(1)(b) GDPR). Personal data will also be processed for the purpose of complying with legal obligations imposed on the Opera, including obligations arising from tax regulations, accounting documentation requirements, and archiving obligations (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR), as well as for the purposes of the Opera's legitimate interests in establishing, pursuing, or defending legal claims (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).
4. Personal data will be processed for the period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are processed. Personal data provided for registration and participation in events will be retained for the duration of the event's implementation, for the period of limitation of claims, and in accordance with applicable laws, including the Opera's records retention schedule.

Personal data in the form of an image processed on the basis of consent may be processed for as long as the Opera pursues its promotional objectives or until consent is withdrawn. Where invoices are issued through the National e-Invoicing System (KSeF), personal data will be processed for a period of 10 years from the date of issuance.

5. Recipients of personal data will include entities to which the Opera is legally obliged to disclose data under applicable laws, as well as entities cooperating with the Opera, including IT service providers, advisory service providers, social media service providers, social media platform administrators, and, where consent has been granted, sponsors and partners. Where structured invoices are issued through KSeF, personal data will also be disclosed to the Head of the National Revenue Administration.
6. Participants' personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes and will not be profiled. The Opera does not transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA) or to international organizations; however, such transfers may occur in connection with the use of specific IT systems (e.g., Google Forms) and the publication of content on social media platforms. In such cases, an adequate level of personal data protection is ensured through the EU–US Data Privacy Framework and Standard Contractual Clauses.
7. Participants have the right to access their personal data and obtain a copy thereof. Participants also have the right to rectify personal data, request its deletion or restriction of processing, the right to data portability, the right to object to processing, and the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
8. If Participants believe that the processing of their personal data by the Opera violates personal data protection laws, they have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych).
9. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary for the purposes specified in point 3 above.
